	Migrant Journeys' project among 34 participants. System and Generation has produced 2000
	copies of the game. The game was played by 700 youngsters in highs school and universities
	in Turkey. In addition, the game was send and played to many of our partners in Italy,
	Slovenia, Romania, Sweden, Bulgaria, Germany, Belgium, United Kingdom, Greece. The
	original version of the Journey is in English, but the game is now translated in Turkish, French,
	Arabic and Albanian.

	<b>NesilFEST (Generation Festival)</b> was developed as an output of the local project called AYNA which our organization implemented last year in cooperation with Turkish Ministry of Family and Social Policy. The idea of the project is to organize a better communication between youth and elderly people, by involving them in different activities. The Project consists of diverse modules for the developement of different skills and competences. As conclusion, our goal is to support adult productivity, youth individuality and youth bio-psycho-social
	development with learning-focused workshops and activities.
	<b>Volunteering for Generation:</b> The main objective of the project is strengthening old and young people's participation in social life, ensuring that old people play an active role in society by reducing the generation gap and contributing to the development of young people's awareness of social responsibility. EVS volunteers will be a part of active living with elderly and people with disabilities to create a model to develop interaction and dialogue between generations of young and old people. The volunteers will be working with a Social Worker on the facilitation of the services delivered for elderly and disabled people. Helping actively for the activities with kids (migrants and locals) and also attending Turkish language classes every week.
